*(The foundation for change is always in the small things)*

*I do not think the world is going to end 2012. This year will come and go like any other year. It is true we have many changes going on, and this is a monumental year in the field of Astronomy and Astrology, because there are so many astrological alignments that rarely happen. What that does mean is that many believe it is the official mark of the end of one age and moving into another. It is advancement for human-kind in all arenas.*

***First let's get the all the Astronomical and Astrological concerns out of the way***

***We begin with the Galactic Setting for December 21, 2012. From an Astronomical standpoint,*** 2012 marks the end of what is known as the procession of the equinoxes - a 25,800 year cycle. December 21, 2012 at 11:11 a.m. GMT (Greenwich Meridian Time) is when the Earth aligns with the Sun and with the Center of our Milky Way galaxy. Some scientists are also predicting that this alignment could lead to an upcoming magnetic pole shift where the planet rotates over its core and the North Pole and South Pole switch positions.

*Magnetic pole shifts have happened before in the history of Earth and happen every eleven years for the sun. NASA says our sun is also going to have a magnetic pole shift in 2012, which leads to larger solar activities and geo-magnetic storms that impact our planet, our communications and our weather patterns. What that means for us is continued erratic weather situations.*

***In Astrology:*** They call the alignment that will be taking place December 21, 2012 "the Dark Rift" can be termed as the cosmic womb. What that means in our language is transformation, regeneration, some will call it "the place of dead," and rebirth. This is the moment that shows the end of the Mayan's calendar.

*It is important to note that the year 2012 is not only the year the calendar system ends a major cycle but also a year including a rare Sun / Venus conjunction. The Maya and other ancient calendar scholars would certainly have considered conjunctions of the Sun and Venus very special. Venus holds a uniquely important place in the planetary mythology for these peoples.*

*To calculate the Sun / Venus occurrence into the future is extremely difficult. It seems these people managed to do just this however. It appears likely they deliberately targeted 2012 at least in part because of the Galactic Alignment to end their calendar for realignment. (Another words, this Mayan calendar now goes back to the beginning and starts all over). Never forget - history always repeats itself. Interestingly enough, this conjunction of the Sun / Venus aspect occurs on 6-5-2012 then just months later again on 03-28-2013. The Maya had the knowledge to predict that special conjunction precisely and accurately to one day.*

*As for cosmic energy having physical effects on Earth in 2012, at this time I can only say that the events described here do not lend themselves to any clear logical reason why December 21, 2012 would be unlike any other day. There are, however, other 2012 avenues to explore related to the 12-21-2012 Galactic Alignment and Sun / Venus conjunction that carries information, theories, and possibilities based on astronomical history for the student who is interested.*

### ***Also the Myths and or Truths about the Mayan Calendar***

***What Did The Mayan Calendar Foresee for 2012?*** *Let's take a look at this Mayan Calendar and attempt to put it in terms you and I can understand and what it could mean to us. .*

*This calendar goes back approximately 26,000 years to what the Mayans considered to be the beginning (or the creation). According to their ancient astronomers, this point of creation occurred when the sun, the moon and the earth were in a line pointing to the center of the Milky Way. The Mayans believed that this place was the center of creation. What we now know is that the center of the Milky Way contains a massive black hole (as do nearly all galaxies.) A great number of astronomers feel that our galaxy evolved or was created from a black hole.*

*There is nothing in the Mayan's mythology to suggest we are facing a great disaster on Earth. The Long calendar count is one of many calendar cycles that they knew about and observed. When it ran out, they just started a new cycle. The Mayans did not advocate this end of the world theory; it's our own interpretation that has led to this thinking. When the Mayans made it to the end of a cycle, they didn't look at it as a doomsday event, it was a huge celebration to make it to the end of a whole cycle.*

*The **New Age** interpretation of this movement - December 21, 2012 - marks the time in which Earth and its inhabitants undergo a positive physical or spiritual transformation, and that 2012 marks the beginning of a new era.*

### ***The 2012 weather and changes it will bring***

*We have already started to see weather patterns that have changed our land structures and the lives of many. This has happened before but not on such a personal level. Remember, we are now able to communicate in real time with anyone on the earth's surface, which makes us all aware of a connection we never considered before. It is the beginning of the awareness of that oneness the great sages talked of so often.*

*We will continue to see these changes between 2012 and 2020. Some will come in the form of natural disasters; but in most instances we will witness it in the form of unusual or extreme weather patterns. There will be other things that will come in the appearances of diseases. We have seen this activity already and will continue to do so. Global climate changes have become apparent and will continue occur until the early 2020's. It's just time for all of this, and of course, Mother Earth is a living organism. There is a great healing taking place with*

*all of this activity as land returns underwater and new land surfaces from the waters. Never forget, water is a great healing agent. We, as humans, have a way of not respecting each other much less our planet. But awareness is being brought into our everyday lives and we are beginning to acknowledge respect for all living creatures and our planet as a living part of our lives.*

*Even though La Nina faded away this past summer, we will see it make a comeback and its influence in weather patterns. We also will be feeling the effects of what is known as The Arctic Oscillation which is a less predictable pattern. It's a 'wild card' influence that results in large short-term swings in temperatures. I feel we will see this in the U. S. during the winter. The erratic Arctic Oscillation generates strong shifts in the climate patterns and will amplify La Nina's impacts.*

*Chicago is predicted by so many forecasters to endure the worst of winters. It is clear to me that Chicago **could** be hard hit, for snow and cold in the winter of 2012, but something would have to change at this point. At this time I see conditions available for such a winter but not likely to happen, although we will have our share of cold weather, and snow. All of us will be ready for the spring.*

*We will see below-average precipitation portions of Texas, Oklahoma, New Mexico and Arizona.*

*Drier-than-average conditions are also expected in parts of the Southeast and Florida as well as portions of the Carolinas, Georgia, and Alabama. Northern Florida is already in drought, so this is not desirable news. Florida could emerge from winter very dry just like last year, and could set the stage for wildfire conditions.*

*Meanwhile, wetter-than-average conditions are forecast from the Pacific Northwest into the Northern Rockies and Northern Plains. The Pacific Northwest is one portion of the country that typically sees above-average precipitation during La Nina winters.*

*I see a concern about the spring flood season; with the expectation of above-average precipitation this winter in the Northern Plains.*

*La Nina in general is not a major influence on weather in the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast, but the Arctic Oscillation can be a big influence. If the combination of enough cold air and moisture come together this winter, we will see above-average snowfall.*

### **What to expect from the Economy for 2012**

*There are a lot of problems that have to be sorted through and worked out in the economy over the next several years before we get back on some sort of growth chart. Wall Street is in its infancy of major changes and it's not going back to what it was pre - 2008. Those days are gone, this sector will emerge differently. It's not going to come back to the way it was - it's a secular change. Wall Street is not going to be as profitable as it has been; therefore people will not make as much money as they were used to in the past. An absence of safe havens will ensure a difficult year for investors in 2012.*

*Daily swings—sometimes 3% or 4% a day—have become a regular occurrence in the financial markets. This is erratic; just because its routine doesn't mean it's any less unsettling. Generally people will continue fail to protect their assets, because they still believe in a system that has disappointed them and, for many, it has lost much of their life's savings or retirement funds.*

*We are exploring alternative employment possibilities and this is a very good thing. I do feel many will need to find new income streams and to prepare for many lifestyle changes. We will see periodic mini-surges on the stock markets and in the economy, but generally this is short lived and gives us a false sense of security.*

*It is my thought; this economic decline will NOT spare the other economies. Emerging markets (China and other Asians markets) can only emerge with strong export demand from the developed markets. I do not see that happening. So many nations having economic crises: riots in Greece, the Iceland government overthrown, Latvia, France, Thailand, the UK, Iran – protests, marches, demonstrations. I am thinking the worst is not over. It's all changing and a new financial world is being designed.*

*I recommend caution but do not foresee a catastrophe year 2012. The United States will likely avoid a recession. There is a need for a strategic framework to deal with this 'new normal'. Slow growth and higher risks are what we are dealing with and it is unlikely that gold will repeat its strong performance in 2012. The Eurozone sovereign-debt crisis is the biggest threat to the US economy. Commodity prices mostly will move sideways. In the case of oil, markets have concerns about an escalation of conflict over Iran's nuclear weapons program. With that said, the most likely scenario is for the price of oil and other commodities to fluctuate around current levels.*

### ***The 2012 Political Scene and the Power struggles***

*(2012-2013 there will be tremendous cultural, social and political upheaval which will further transform governments and political structures.)*



*I see more incumbents voted out of office, both Republicans and Democrats, and I am not even sure if this has ever happened. Americans are not happy with anyone right now.*

*The States - Eleven states have governorships for elections in the 2012. It is my thought that Delaware, Missouri, New Hampshire, and Vermont are likely going to Democrats, while North Dakota and Utah will stay in GOP hands. Indiana, might flip to the Democrats, it's a long shot for sure but possible. The other four States -- Montana, North Carolina, Washington, and West Virginia – I just don't know right now.*

*The House - With all 435 voting Congressional seats open again, we're going to see some changes happen in the 2012 House elections. The current House, with its right-wing majority, has an approval rating in the lower twenties, which might sound good to Democrats but they shouldn't believe everything they hear and read. Congress usually works with approval ratings well below the 50% mark, so it doesn't really say much about the election. If the conservatives in the House hope to keep their jobs in 2012, they need to spend more time satisfying the needs and desires of their constituents. As it stands today, I'm predicting a majority status for Democrats in 2012*

*The Senate - The Democrats have 23 Senate seats up, and 2 seats belonging to independents who generally side with Democrats. Republicans only have 10 seats up for election. The Democrat seats up for election are in places like New York and California, where incumbent Democrats are very strong and likely to keep their seats. Joe Lieberman is retiring, which leaves Connecticut for someone new. They will likely elect a Democrat. Seven Democratic seats and 3 Republican seats are up for election or re-election - ever how you want to look at it. I see a Democratic senate but it will be below super-majority. My early Senate predictions are that the Senate will go 55/ 45 in favor of the Democrats.*

*The White House - I believe the White House is the easiest to predict out of all. It would take some major nation-changing events to shake up this race's outcome. President Obama has no real electoral threats opposing him. It is clear; he is the pick for the 2012 Presidential election. The more radical the GOP are for president, the higher President Obama's approval ratings will go.*

*Many would like to see Hillary Clinton run for Vice President with Obama and I want to say it is not out of the question. The current vice president would move into another position. V.P. Joe Biden is strong in foreign affairs; but he can be offensive in his approach and delivery tactics with others. It appears to me that so far this administration has not been able to get a handle on this problem. At this time, Secretary of State would not be a good place for Mr. Biden; although you can count on it as a consideration if Hillary is the running mate of Barack Obama.*

*What have we seen with this administration?*

- 1. Even though Obama is charismatic or some feel a national hero... He led from behind. He didn't take the lead in the healthcare debate; he didn't use his speaking ability to move the American people during the recession. He's lost his ability to connect since the 2008 election. I do not see the challenging party candidates considered charismatic or national heroes.*
- 2. Obama's administration suffers no major failure in foreign or military affairs. We haven't seen any major failure that resembles the Bay of Pigs and I don't foresee anything.*
- 3. Obama's administration achieves a major plus in military affairs because Osama bin Laden was found and killed.*
- 4. Where foreign policy is concerned, I see that the end of the Iraq war and pulling all the troops out of Iraq will be attributed to Mr. Obama's watch. Because of this, I can see the*

*history books will be very favorable to Mr. Obama for his achievements in Foreign policy and, of course, the success in military affairs.*

- 5. Obama's administration has made major policy changes, contrary to what we hear, or you would want to believe. We've seen the biggest stimulus in history and a complete overhaul of the healthcare system. So I give him credit for policy change. Now that doesn't mean you have to like it, or not like it, I simply mean CHANGE is what the Obama administration ran their campaign on and he has delivered change .*

*On the GOP side for their elections, Mitt Romney is the only candidate that can give Obama any kind of successful run for a Republican for president. Newt Gingrich has lots of experience but for some reason I do not see him as a good compete for Obama. I like Mitt Romney very much and I do feel he would be a good selection for the GOP. I do not see that his religion will keep this party from determining that Mitt Romney as their best candidate. Anything that is divisive to the GOP party as a whole needs to be examined. The way I see it, the GOP needs to move into a more united front; deciding what is best for their party and our country through their vision would be the most reasonable and logical thing they can do to compete with some integrity in the presidential elections. . Oh BTW, Mitt Romney's choice for vice president more than likely will be Sen. Marco Rubio (R-FL).*

*President Obama is aligning himself more and more with President Bill Clinton. History has been very kind to Mr. Clinton, and our president knows that this man has great skills that he himself is lacking. When we talk the Clintons; we are talking powerful influential people, and Mr. and Mrs. are 100% in Obama's corner. That is good for the party and good for the election.*

*We are likely to see an increase in stability and a more practical approach to economics and business than we have seen in quite a while. The inflated bonuses for CEOs that we saw in recent years are a sign of the past as businesses and corporations become more concerned with fundamental appearance and image, plus achievements, real goals and objectives as time proceeds on. There will be an increased focus on proficiency, skill, and a successful outcome.*

*I see many more secrets revealed in all governments and other political agencies. Celebrity figures, no matter if they are in sports, movies, big business, there are no favorites or exceptions - it's time for exposing what people do; and, think for that matter, within the confines of their own minds.*

### ***Taking a look at foreign affairs from the U.S. point of view in 2012***

***Iran*** –*I do not see an attack on Iran by either Israel or the United States over the next 12 months. (But it is a delicate area, and, to be honest, anything can happen. We are dealing with the Middle East.) What I do see is the entire network that helped get us into Iraq has re-surfaced, attempting to encourage the United States to strike Iran.*

***AIPAC*** - *The AIPAC (American Israel Public Affairs) conference in March will be proclaimed the "most successful" in its history. The talk, of course, will be about confronting Iran. One of the main goals, as I see it, will be to convey to Congress that supporting AIPAC on matters to the Middle East is the only way to stay out of political trouble. As a result, Congress will pass at least one piece of legislation reprimanding the Palestinians and I am sure we will see more action against Iran.*

***Arab Spring***: *In 2012, I believe I see the Syrian government dissolve. Just a horrible situation and then moving to some form of democracy for these people will be as hard as it is in Egypt.*

**Israelis and Palestinians** - Both will be dealing with a government, and in the case of the Palestinians, a quasi-government that will be primarily concerned with continuing the power it already has. Both countries will continue advocating whatever it needs to, to stay in power, and neither country will engage in, what I see or want to call, genuine negotiations.

**Pakistan** – Pakistan's Zardari is likely to fall away.

**Greece** - I see this Mediterranean nation beginning official negotiations to exit the Eurozone in 2012. It occurs to me that this is the result of Greece's next parliamentary election.

**China** - will ease up on currency controls. Due to the outrageous exchange rate for the Chinese Renminbi, I see it will slowly and rather quietly, loosen its monetary policy and allow the currency "to rise 6-8% against the dollar. China will see the first glimmers of real political unrest within its borders.

**Russia** – It looks like to me, Former President Putin will have several assassination attempts. I would be surprised if he survived these opposing political members. President Putin is a man who has a lot of influence over Russia and the people. There are people and forces who want to remove that influence.

**Japan** - Economies like Japan and the U.S. will be beneficiaries of the Eurozone crisis.

**Africa** – I think the U.S. will move more toward counter-terrorism in Africa. Particularly countries like Nigeria (where Islamist activities from groups like Boko Haram).

### **What we will see in 2012 - CHANGE, CHANGE, CHANGE, AND MORE CHANGE**

*(Transformation in our personal and global lives are designed to bring balance,  
When that balance occurs then we have had enough change.)*

*The transformations I see can be a bit ruthless, but it is not cruel. We see the need to eliminate that which is no longer working so that new life can survive. It's all about progression and it is the way life works. Some call it the evolution of our mind creating outward situations to keep our lives in sync.*

*I feel that over the next little while we will see the elderly and end- of-life issues transform. The way we view the entire process of death and dying, including the disposal of the body after death.*

*Marriage is more and more falling away. As I see it, marriage can become an obsolete word within the next 50 years. I am not sure of all the reasons, but marriage has fallen short of expectations continuously. Money will always rule the company's voice not the people.*

*The Occupy movement is only one force; more will appear and join their forces and causes together. The people in power, at this time, will not be able to ignore the issues and or consequences of these groups. They will be a powerful movement like we have never seen before. They are willing to do what it takes to get this job done for the common good of all not just the few that appear to be benefitting at this time.*

*New laws will be written to control the power of BIG business. The Big bonuses, unbelievable compensations and outrageous paychecks for CEO's at banks and Wall Street also will be brought into alignment. So many changes are coming to equalize our people and living conditions.*

### **2012 Health Watch**

*Among the key issues, we'll see value move from theory to reality. Insurers gear up to compete in a new insurance exchange marketplace and healthcare increasing its social media presence.*

*Come 2012, it looks like almost 70% of employers will be charging higher contributions for dependent coverage and dropping retiree accounts. I predict ¼ of the companies will drop their retirees' coverage. As that continues on, "we the people" will not be able to sustain that kind of cost. America can no longer sustain a **FOR PROFIT** health care system. I believe what I see here is the insurance companies' being phased out over the next 10 years, or totally redefined. But I feel their profits will be absorbed by other big businesses and they will just fade away.*

*The people don't have the money to play their insurance game and big business is not willing to fork over money to them to keep insuring their employees. So...if you have no consumers, you have no business. The insurance companies will literally out price themselves. We will find ourselves on a program that the government has their hands in, or none of us will be able to afford healthcare. This program will resemble Medicare and, by the way, it will work. We will be responsible to pay our part, it will not be free, and Medicaid (what welfare recipients have) will be redefined. That is a system that has needed to be reviewed for many years.*

*Remember, our pay scale was stagnant for years and now has decreased, which means to us that businesses are hiring at a much lower pay scale than before. Our necessities have gone up, water, gas heating oil, electric, food and clothing, the money isn't there for healthcare. Changes have to occur; this is not working any longer for the masses.*

*The med-tech tattoo coming soon. It's a hair-thin, stick-on micro-electronic tattoo and has similar properties to skin. This medical invention could be used to monitor more subtle processes, such as the movement of enzymes, antibodies, or pathogens. It will be powered by solar cells; the data collected can be transmitted wireless to a remote computer for analysis.*

*Needle-less Injection will arrive in 2012. As an alternative to a needle, microporation is a painless method of transferring medication into the body using laser technology. It will be a handheld laser placed on the skin for the transfer of medicine molecules. It will be painless to use and requires no supervision to administer. The interfaced controls regulate the dosage.*

*The E-Button - created to combat obesity and will be ready to use in the U.S. shortly. It includes a tiny camera, an accelerometer, a GPS and other sensors that track data about daily activities. This will be worn on the chest like a pin, eliminates the need for self-reporting of events like meals and exercise.*

*Touch Screen Phones! Coming soon... Our touch screen phones to be used like a mini-lab for diagnose diseases. This technology is capable to work through electrical changes made by the fingertip's movements. These phones will serve as a highly sensitive detection platform for diseases. This technology will give rapid results in hospitals, and mean fewer trips to the doctor for minor illness. Your phone will have the capability to send the results to your doctor, who could call in a prescription.*

*An invisible thin glass coating invention is a spray-on invisible thin glass coating that sterilizes, protects and strengthens surfaces. It repels water, dirt, stains, mildew, fungus, bacteria and viruses. (It is 500 times thinner than a human hair strand) Items such as stents can be coated, and this will create anti sticking features. Catheters and sutures which are a source of infection will cease to be problematic.*

### ***Technology and Inventions - 2012 is the beginning of so many changes***

*(A new Industrial Revolution and Scientific Revolution will begin.)*

**Microsoft** – *For 2012 Microsoft will think about negotiate with Nokia to start making its own phones. Not sure how that will work, but something is going on with Microsoft and we will know all about it but fall. It will unveil a model that will be superior to the iPhone. Around the summer time, we will hear about a Microsoft-Skype. This will be the most important achievement in office telecommunications since email. Microsoft's success will cause the stock soar!*

*People from all different backgrounds are seeking a direct experience of the divine, and conventional religious theology does not satisfy the inner longing. 


