## **WEATHER**

Wetter-than-average conditions most likely in the Southern Tier of the United States. Drier-than-average conditions most likely for Hawaii, central and western Alaska, parts of the Pacific Northwest and northern Rockies, and for areas near the Great Lakes and Ohio Valley.

**Temperature** - Above-average temperatures across much of the West and the northern half of the United States. Also above-average in Alaska and much of Hawaii. Below-average temperatures are most likely in the southern Plains and Southeast.

**Drought** - shows some improvement in central and southern California by the end of January, but not drought removal. Drought is likely to persist in the Pacific Northwest. While it is good news that drought improvement is predicted for California, one season of above-average rain is unlikely to remove four years of drought. California would need close to twice its normal rainfall to get out of drought and that's unlikely."

This will be due to environmental changes. We will continue to see very hot, very cold, the usual earthquakes, and tornadoes. ## World

**Starting in 2016** - China builds the longest undersea tunnel in the world. China's latest megaproject is a 76 mile (122 km) undersea tunnel running from Dalian to Yantai. It surpasses the combined length of the world's two longest undersea tunnels –It will cut previous journeys by 800 miles, it forms a vital high-speed rail link between the north and south of the country, boosting economic growth significantly.



A collection of events will cause North Korea to go through several major governmental changes.

**The Panama Canal** widening will be completed and open for business in early 2016. An extra \$400 million dollar loan will aid to complete this long-delayed project. This is going to help to keep independent contractors paid, and get the construction completed.

**India** will have their first manned space flight in 2016. When that happens, India becomes only the fourth nation – after Russia, the US and China – to independently launch humans into space.

**This year** the US firm Orbital Technologies in partnership with the Russian the space group, Energiya, we will see the launching the world's first space hotel capable of housing up to seven people. It offers spectacular views of the Earth and includes a menu crafted by celebrity chefs. It also functions as a possible emergency refuge for astronauts from the International Space Station.

**America's Juno probe** will land on Jupiter as planned in July without incident. its mission concludes in October 2017, after a total of 33 orbits.

Recent years we seen a rapid increase in the use of automation, this trend that is becoming prevalent in the mining sector. Wireless, intelligent devices are able to communicate with each other to monitor environmental conditions and to automate control of the mines.

This year as the use of robots machinery continues to increase, mining will begin to expand into new environments and locations that were previously off-limits to humans. This includes the seafloor, rich in metals like gold, copper, manganese, nickel and cobalt. Longer term plans are being made to exploit asteroids.

Because of automated robots, many entry level jobs are now disappearing, just like we have seen in every other industry that has gone to automation.

**Agricultural robots are appearing on farm** - Significant numbers of robots are now appearing on farms. These have been in development for 20 years and are now cheap and sophisticated enough for mainstream use. The increased output helps to alleviate food shortages caused by rising global populations. Despite these gains, agricultural robots prove controversial. Mechanization continues its unending progress, as yet another industry begins to be handed over to machines.

**China this year will complete the largest environmental cleanup in history** - To rectify these conditions, the Chinese government in 2011 began clean up the damage done. A tax was applied to heavy polluters, based on the output of hazardous chemicals and sewage. The goal was to fix the situation. New regulations are introduced, putting a cap on energy use.

Though some progress has been made over this five year period, the entrenchment of dirty industry and the explosive growth of the country makes it very difficult to turn the environmental situation around. It will take decades of further work before China has transitioned to a truly green economy.

## **ECONOMY**

**STOCK MARKETS** - We are looking over-inflated and due for imminent correction, but they can continue to grow this year until August. In August, we could see some sharp drops. I am uncertain what could trigger the next crisis, bubbles do not burst simply because financial assets are overvalued. By late 2016, markets would probably be extremely vulnerable to a crash, given lofty valuations. The outcome of the presidential election will have its usual influence on the stock market.

**Global markets** are fragile right now. Since the last financial crisis, governments have tried to print away their problems. They've piled on debt. And most are devaluing their currencies.

I believe **China** is currently in the range of 3 to 5 percent growth, and headed rapidly to near zero. Its China's turn in the barrow, due to debt buildup, excessive problems in reforming their state-owned enterprises. In the longer run, I think they can expect growth at 4 percent. At most. The big losers here are Brazil, Peru, Singapore and other parts of Asia, as well as Africa. The United States will chug along at 2 percent growth..

In all areas, worldwide manipulation will continue: stock markets, foreign exchange, interest rates, commodities, real estate and, of course, gold. Banks will continue to be unaccountable: recently five big banks were fined billions regarding foreign exchange rigging, but still no one takes responsibility and they still don't want to be regulated. In the long run, gold will go up. Don't lose faith and if you have gold, don't be tempted to sell.

Battling back from an economic crisis requires hard work, savings. There's no magic pill, entitlement program, or paper money bomb that will suddenly make things better.

## **INVENTIONS**

**By the end of 2016 a wireless, implantable device** that monitors a range of health conditions in real time will be the norm. Actually I feel this miniature device is now available. It can monitor a range of substances in the blood, and provide instant results via mobile phone. How it works is by a needle placed just beneath the skin. This needle can remain in the body for months before needing to be replaced or removed.

Data is transmitted via Bluetooth to a mobile phone, which can then be sent to a doctor, if necessary. With direct and continuous monitoring in real time, it is particularly useful for chronic conditions such as diabetes and high cholesterol, as well as tracking the impact of drug treatments such as chemotherapy.

It will be used to warn of an impending heart attack. How that works is a molecule called troponin is released by heart muscle several hours before a heart attack and once the heart muscle starts malfunctioning. This can be detected by the implant before a fatal event occurs. That will give the user time to seek treatment. Although all this technology is still in its infancy, these devices represent a new and emerging generation of personalized medicine that will revolutionize healthcare in the decades ahead. By 2040, such implants are commonplace – even in healthy people.

### **Other Possibilities I see by 2016-2025 AI (Artificial Intelligent) technology**

**What is Artificial intelligence (AI)** - is an area of computer science that emphasizes the creation of intelligent machines that work and react like humans. Some of the activities computers with artificial intelligence are designed for include:

1. Speech recognition
2. Learning
3. Planning
4. Problem solving

- AI technology imitating thinking processes of the brain
- AI teachers get better results than most human teachers
- Computers write most of their own software
- Human knowledge is exceeded by machine knowledge
- Smart makeup works to improve people's looks
- Police force privatized in many nations
- Retirement age begins to be linked to a person's medical history
- Thought recognition as an everyday input process

- Self-diagnostic, self-repairing robots
- War fought entirely between robot armies
- ID cards replaced by biometric scanning
- Life expectancy approaches 100

## MEDICAL

I see as time moves forward diseases will be treated and healed by light and rays.

The very end of 2016-2017. **The world's first HIV vaccine is commercially available.** This vaccine known as SAV001 has completed Phase 1 human clinical, II, and III. This ground-breaking genetically modified technique killed whole-virus vaccine. By the end of 2016-2017, it is becoming commercially available.

**Tooth regeneration is transforming dental care** – We will be able to regrow a fully functional, living tooth in around two months. Another technique I see emerging this year is Electrically Accelerated and Enhanced Remineralization (EAER). This allows a decayed tooth to effectively repair and heal itself without the need for drills, needles or fillings. Fillings and dentures will gradually become obsolete as a result of these and other new treatments, improving the health and well-being of millions of people.

On the cutting edge - Energy medicine - nutrition, preventative health and wellness healthy eating, raw foods, healthy thinking. Kind of the same old stuff only now being thought of in a higher octave. Old concepts, but new ways for more effective healing.

Rejuvenation techniques - plastic surgery and anything involving anti-aging. The perfection of health techniques e.g. micro surgery, nano-surgery, non-invasive surgeries, robotics, stem cell transplantation, and cancer immunotherapy

**Three person Babies** - A new method of IVF which involves the creation of babies with three parents. This will be introduced in the UK first, I believe. The controversial technique uses DNA from parents and combines it with healthy mitochondria from a female donor. This can prevent rare, and potentially fatal diseases. Although the baby has genetic material from three people, regulations state that for legal purposes it has two and the donor remains anonymous. During experiments the treatment is shown to be safe. More advanced techniques will emerge in the decades ahead, leading to “designer babies” for the wealthy.

**Finally a pill to prevent sunburn!** Who would have guessed? And ...Further research on this compound is underway, as it has the potential to create sun-tolerant plants. This pathway could make it possible to grow temperate crops, such as wheat and potatoes, at high yields in the tropics.



**Gene Editing Using CRISPR** - Once, altering the DNA of human embryos, was the stuff of science fiction. No more. This year, a new inexpensive technique called CRISPR, or gene editing is being adopted in labs everywhere.

CRISPR, which stands for “clustered regularly interspaced short palindromic repeats,” is being touted as a way to eliminate genetic diseases. It can identify and remove bad genes from a DNA strand for as little as \$30. What this means to us is that CRISPR’s impact on the human population will be tremendous.

Cancer Screening via Protein Biomarker Analysis – Coming In 2016, a new biomarker platform is hitting the market that should offer more accurate cancer screenings and more chances of early detection.

### **NEW MOVEMENTS**

A new drive towards spirituality will begin to gather speed. We will see leaders devoted to helping the sick and the poor will emerge. Also young people with a huge purpose will appear on the world stage to bring in new concepts for love and peace and how to actualize it.

Beginning this year, we will find cures for diseases that have been with us for eons. We are learning ways to bring cohesion using medical science and natural healing technics. Doctors are now able to integrate both of these systems for more comprehensive solutions of getting well and staying healthy.

I see more and more air travel as aviation develops. We will see planes with supersonic speeds.

This is only a portion of the possibilities and promises of a new way. All having it roots in 2016.
